Damaged or overheated Lithium-Ion batteries are an extreme fire hazard and may explode. Do not dispose these batteries in trash receptacles. Devices powered by these batteries include cell phones, cordless tools, lap top computers and toys. Lithium-Ion and standard batteries may be recycled, free of charge, at the Lyon County Hazardous Waste Department, 3000 W. South Avenue, Emporia 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. M-F. Residents are asked to tape the positive terminal on every battery before recycling to avoid spark.
